

4 DAYS GLIMPSES OF NEPAL



DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR – KATHMANDU

(Dinner)

Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, our local representative will meet and greet you at the airport then transfer to hotel check-in, at leisure.

DAY 02 KATHMANDU

(Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

After breakfast, visit the 2000 year-old Swoyambhunath Stupa, (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), also known as the "Monkey temple". The temple is known for its dazzling Stupas and offers views of Kathmandu city. The two-thousand year-old Stupa is the most profound expression of Nepalese Buddhist symbolism. There is evidence to believe the hill was used for animist rites even before Buddhism arrived in the valley two thousand years ago. Visiting the Patan Durbar Square (UNESCO World Heritage Site) the Patan Durbar Square complex is probably the most photographed in the three durbar squares. It is located in the heart of Patan city and was once the palace of the kings of Patan. The square is a display of the Newarian architecture, which reached its pinnacle during the reign of Malla king. Next up is Khokana. Khokana is a small Newari Village located just 6 km from Patan. The traditional craftsmanship in Khokana is still an important part of this. Villagers are often spinning, winnowing and crushing mustard seeds. The village has a broad street leading to its center. On the left side you can see the three-story Shree Rudrayani temple. We will walk about 15 minutes to Bungmati. Like Khokana, Bungmati is also a Newarian village and has a typical Newarian building and an interesting main square where people can admire the Ganesh Temple and the Machhindranath Temple.

DAY 03 KATHMANDU

(Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

Full day city tour includes the famous Durbar Square of Kathmandu, dominated by Shiva temple where the "Living virgin Goddess" overlooks the square from the south; Proceed to Kirtipur. Kirtipur is located 5 km from the center of Kathmandu. In Nepali dialect Kirtipur means "a glorious town". Looking down from its natural order it has been the scene of many historic battles and many important moments in Nepal's history. History says that the ancient city Kirtipur was founded by Shiva Deva between 1099 AD. Kirtipur town is a harmonica convergence of Buddhist and Hindus. Next up is Pashupatinath Temple. (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). Pashupatinath is one of the holiest pilgrimage destinations for all the Hindus of the world. The temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva, one of the trinity and the guardian (patron) deity of Nepal. This is one of the oldest temples, situated on the banks of the Holy Bagmati River. It is double – roofed golden temple with four triple silver doorways. Pashupatinath covers an area of 281 hectares, which is one of the biggest temple complexes in Nepal. Although Pashupatinath Temple was only built in the fifth century and later renovated by Malla kings, the holy site is said to have existed from the beginning of the millennium. The last attraction of the day will be the Great Stupa of Boudhanath (UNESCO World Heritage Site) a vast dome-shaped monument representing the Mind of the Buddha. It is the primary pilgrimage destination for Tantric Buddhists of the Himalayas and a major draw for Tibetan Buddhists from all over the planet. The history of the Stupa from its origins in the fifth century to the present day is also presented here for the first time. Drive back to hotel. This evening, attend a farewell dinner with cultural show.
