

7 DAYS SEOUL/ MT SORAK/ JEJU ISLAND



Day 01 Arrival Seoul (Morning) → Jeju Island by domestic flight ****Sat ~ Thu only** (- / Lunch / Dinner)

Hwan-yeonghabnida ! Our professional tour guide cum driver will meet and greet you at Incheon International Airport. Sightseeing tour begins with Namshangol Hanok Village where offers one the opportunity to experience a wide cross-section of Joseon-era citizenry and activities, from royalty to commoners. Transfer to Gimpo Airport for a domestic flight to Jeju Island. Visit Yongduam Rock, located on the Northern Beach of Jeju City . Then we will drive through a mystery road near Jeju city, the locals call it Dokkaebi Road. It is mysterious because objects on this road seem to defy the laws of gravity! Check-in to your hotel after dinner.

Day 02 Jeju Island (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

Today, Jeju Island Full-Day Tour includes Seongsan lichubong, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. There is a huge crater at the top of Seongsan lichubong Peak, the sunrise from the crater is magnificent. Next is Seongeup Folk Village and Seopjikoji. Seopjikoji is famous for its scenic view of Rapeseed fields (Rapeseed season: end of March ~ Beginning of April), lighthouse by the cliff and the filming sites. Jeju Traditional Market is one of the highlights of today.

Day 03 Jeju Island → Seoul by domestic flight – Mt. Sorak ****Sat ~ Thu only** (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

Return to Seoul by domestic flight. Visit the island of “Winter Sonata” ~ Nami Island and then Petite France. Petite France is a popular place to visit because there have been many Korean TV series filmed here. Proceed to Mt. Sorak hotel accommodation.

Day 04 Seoul (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

In the morning, visit Mt. Sorak National Park and Shinheungsa Temple (Seoraksan). On the path to Sinheungsa, you can see the great bronze statue called Bronze Jwabal Statue, which is well over 10 meters high. Then visit Gwangmyeong Cave, the largest themed cave park in Korea with combination of industrial heritage and cultural value, and accomplished the miracle of an abandoned mine. After lunch, drive back to Seoul, visit N Tower (Outward) and the Love Lock Wall at Namsan Park. Check-in to hotel after dinner.

Day 05 Seoul (Breakfast/ - / -)

After breakfast, visit the largest theme park in South Korea ~ Everland (Includes passport ticket) + Wild Safari. Cosmetic outlets and Hongdae Art Street are also in your travel list today. Complimentary tour of Yeouido Island will be arranged during the Sakura Season (1-20 Apr)**Cherry blossom forecast will change due to weather conditions.

Day 06 Seoul (Breakfast/ Lunch/ -)

Today, Seoul City Excursions Tour includes Gyeongbokgung Palace, Ginseng & Herbal Shops, DIY Kimbap & Hanbok Wearing Tour, Cheongyecheon Stream (an 11 km long modern stream that runs through downtown Seoul) , Hujanbao Shop or Red Pine Shop and Myeongdong (a shopping area packed with international fashion brands, luxury department stores and homegrown cosmetics shops).

Day 07 Depart Seoul (Breakfast)

Transfer to Incheon International Airport for your homebound flight.
