

5 Days Yangon-Kyaikhtiyo-Bago



Day 01 Kuala Lumpur - Yangon

(Lunch, Dinner)

Meet and greet upon arrival at Yangon International Airport. Our city tour began in downtown Yangon, surrounded by various colonial style buildings of World War II and Independent Monuments. See the daily life of the local people; Visit Chauk Htat Kyi, a colossal reclining Buddha and the world famous Golden Stupa Shwedagon Pagoda – the golden dome is 98 meters above the base and covered by 60 tons of pure gold. Evening walk to China Town where you can see many vendors are selling a wide variety of Myanmar products on the platform. Check in hotel after dinner.

Day 02 Yangon - Kyaikhtiyo

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Breakfast at hotel. Drive to Kyaikhtiyo – the largest domestic tourism center located about 168 kms from Yangon. Visit the mystical Golden Rock Pagoda which stands on a gold gilded boulder, precariously perched on the edge of a hill over 1100 kms above sea level. There are many legends about the pagoda and Nats (Spirit gods) shrines along the 11 kms uphill *Remarks : Cars/Coaches will stop at Kinpun base camp then you will take the shared trucks (open top & without air conditioning) to the truck terminal near the foot of Golden Rock Pagoda (2km uphill trek to the summit). Overnight in Kyaikhtiyo.

**Note: Due to the heavy rain season, we do not recommend our passengers traveling in July and August.

Day 03 Kyaikhtiyo – Bago - Yangon

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Breakfast at hotel. Today we drive to Bago – an ancient Capital of Mon Kingdom in 15 century, located 80 kms North East of Yangon. Bago tour includes : Shwemawdaw Pagoda-an old pagoda over 1200 year-old; Kanbawzathadi Palace; Shwethalyaung Pagoda, a huge reclining Buddha built during the 9th century. Drive back to Yangon in the evening.

Day 04 Yangon

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Breakfast at hotel. Visit the Mahapasana Cave where the 6th Buddhist synod took place. Then visit Kaba Aye Pagoda and the Myanmar famous precious Gems, Jade & Jewellery workshops. Lunch at local restaurant. Enjoy the fun of bargaining around this sprawling covered market ~ Bogyoke Aung San, known as Scott Market (closes on Mon & Public Holidays). Dinner with cultural show at Karaweik Palace – a famous floating restaurant located on the Royal Lake built in the style of Royal Barge used by Myanmar's old days kings.

Day 05 Yangon - Kuala Lumpur

(Breakfast)

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to airport for homebound flight.
